#### WHAT IS A MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Biennially, in the odd number of years, the voters of Portsmouth holds an election to elect its governing bodies such as:

- City Council
- School Board
- Fire and Police Commissions
- Board of Registrars
- Ward Officials



#### VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- ⇒ 18 Years of Age, *or will be 18 prior to election date.*
- ⇒ Photo ID
- ⇒ Proof of Residency (*Portsmouth Physical Address*)
- ⇒ Must be a U.S. Citizen/Naturalized Citizen
