The following questions have been asked and answered.
The questions are in bold and the answers are italicized.

Question #1 Does the topographic survey and existing conditions plan require a NH surveyor stamp?

Yes

Question #2 Is there a design budget for the project?

No

Question #3 Is funding local or is there state or federal monies involved?

Local funding only.

Question #4 Schedule, The proposed schedule is very tight; weather is mentioned as a factor in starting the project, if permitting is required, will there be an adjustment in the schedule to complete the scope of work should permitting delay completion of the drawings?

Yes.

Question #5 What is the estimated schedule for review of proposals and selection of a firm?

Intent is for final selection no later than November 30, 2009.

Question #6 The trail section requiring re-design to address erosion issues, is the erosion do to a significant storm event or other factors?

Erosion has been an ongoing issue since the trail segment was initially constructed.

Question #7 Is there a written portion of the 1997 Master Plan and if so is it available for review?

There is no accompanying text to the Peirce Island Master Plan.

Question #8 Can you clarify the tide line being sought, the RFP mentions observable, however interpretation of a debris line could be significantly different than an astronomical tide?

Consultants should consult relevant permitting agencies for guidance.

Question #9 Are the project technical specifications to follow the city format?

Yes

Question #10 Should permitting be required it is assumed the city would be responsible for any fees?

Correct.

Question #11 When is the cut off for questions regarding the RFP?

Thursday, November 12 at noon with answers provided no later than Friday November 13 at noon on the City's web page under the project heading.
