Upcoming Night Work on Peirce Island

PORTSMOUTH, NH – The City of Portsmouth will be performing planned work related to the Peirce Island Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) upgrade outside of the typical work hours of 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. during the week of June 5, 2017. The City's WWTF upgrade contractor will be performing underground piping interconnections during periods of low flow in the sewer system overnight. This work is planned to be performed in one overnight shift and is weather dependent. Efforts will be made to minimize the noise associated with this work. This Contractor's work will be performed on Peirce Island at the Wastewater Treatment Facility, while City staff will be at the Mechanic Street Pumping Station during this time period.
