Public Information Meeting for Hodgson Brook Culvert Replacement to be held Thursday, April 14th

PORTSMOUTH, NH – Representatives from the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (DOT) will host a public information meeting regarding plans for the replacement of a culvert on Hodgson Brook on Thursday, April 14th at 6:30 p.m. in Conference Room A of City Hall.

Hodgson Brook is a small freshwater stream that flows through the heart of Portsmouth. The brook originates in uplands west of the City and continues easterly to North Mill Pond, which empties into the Piscataqua River. DOT officials are hosting this meeting to discuss and solicit input from Public Works and other interested individuals concerning the bridge rehabilitation of the US Route 1 Bypass over Hodgson Brook.
