




PURPOSE OF PROJECT

- Separate flows from the sanitary sewer and storm drains
- Reduce combined sewer overflows
- Required by EPA and NHDES
- Reconfigure "backlot" services
- Replace utilities:
 - Water mains & services,
 - Sewer mains & services
 - Storm drainage
- Incorporate LID stormwater treatment
- Reconstruct streets and sidewalks

TREE REVIEW






- Roadway width: don't make too narrow

- Construction in Coffins Court




PROPOSED ROADWAY <u>CROSS SECTION</u> UNION STREET






UNION STREET TYPICAL (STATE STREET TO AUSTIN STREET)



UNION STREET TYPICAL (AUSTIN STREET TO MIDDLE STREET)


PROPOSED ROADWAY CROSS SECTION AUSTIN STREET

ROADWAY & SIDEWALK LAYOUT















STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

- Roadway grading & paving
- Curbing
- Water Quality "BMP's" (Best Management Practices)







- Reconfigured sewer to eliminate backlot sewer
- Separation of sewer/drain required raising the sewer main in Union Street
- Review basements that need reconfiguration with a plumber
- If reconfiguration of plumbing is required because of changes to sewer mains: City expense
