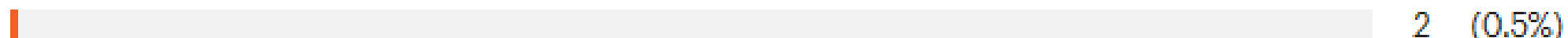

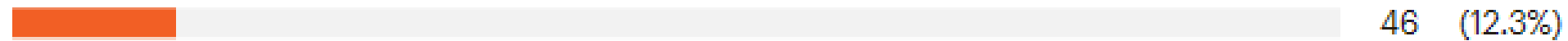


## “If your answer to Question 1 was Eversource, why did you make that choice?”

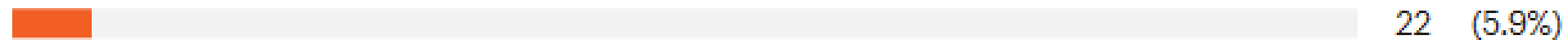

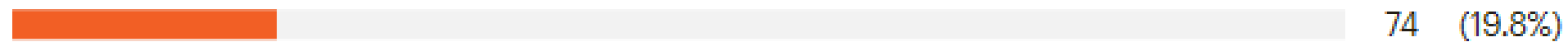

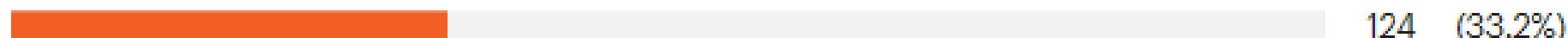

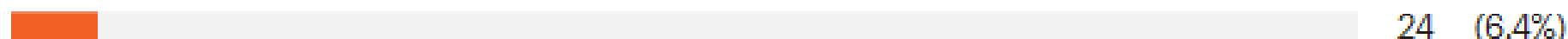


## “Which option would be most important to you in the Portsmouth Community Power program?”

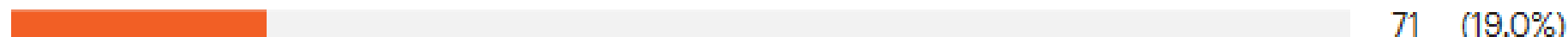
Lowest cost energy option



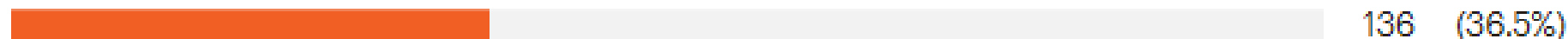
50% renewable energy that may or may not cost more



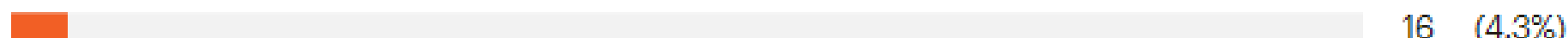

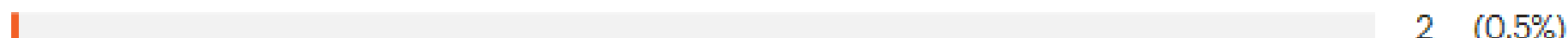

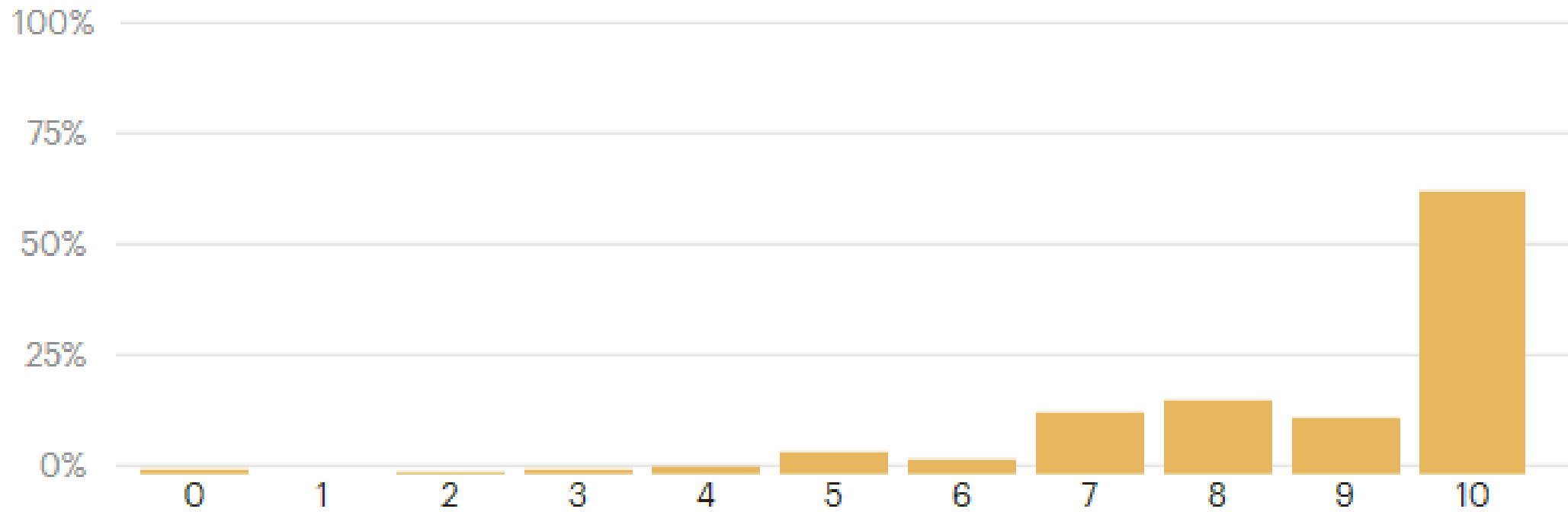

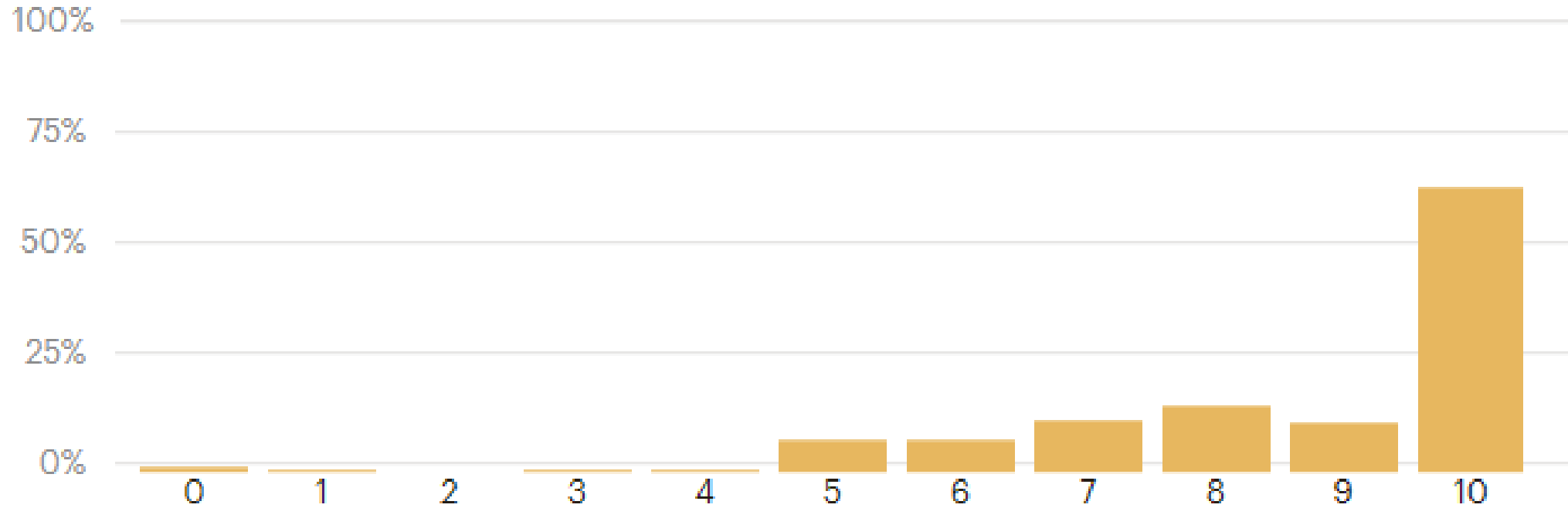
What survey participants want to see

Average = 8.7

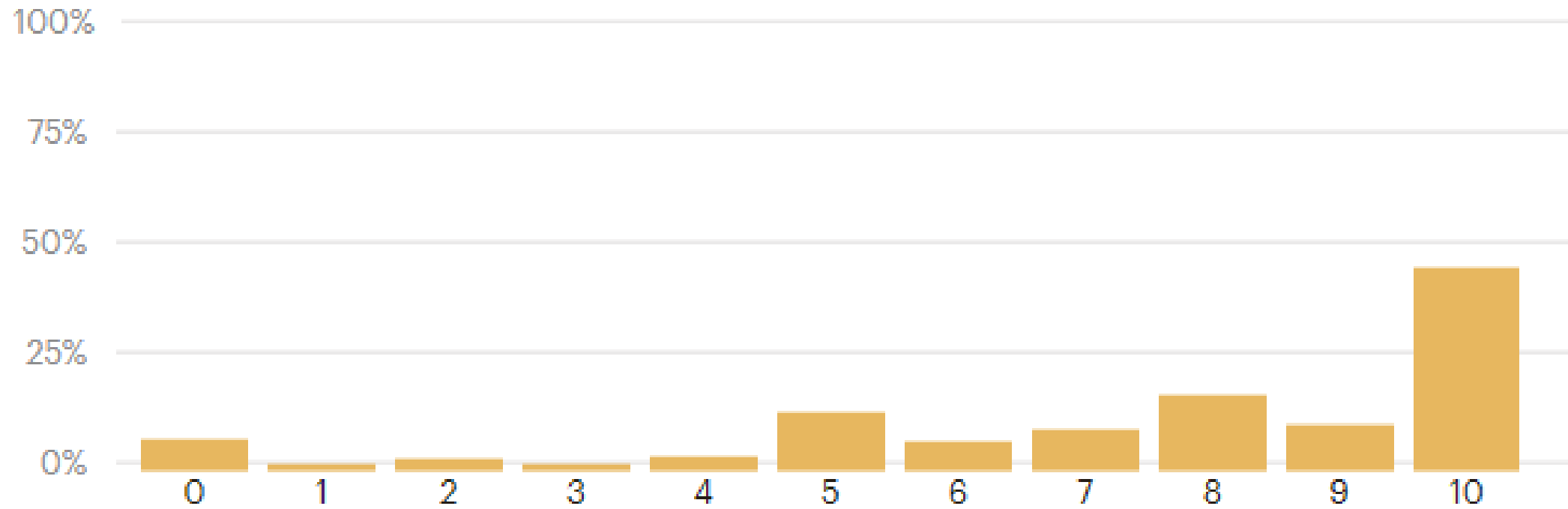
# “Control of energy costs”
