Discussion of:

• Organization's Conservations Assessments (or statements of need)

Emma: Historical Society obtained a quote for \$8000 and will seek a second quote. Scope is the current third floor collection. Hoping to reduce the cost to \$5000.

Elizabeth: Quote is \$4000 (\$800/day). There's multiple types of objects to assess. She is hoping to narrow down the scope of the work by doing some of it themselves via assisting the assessor.

Each unit is paying for their own assessments. Goal to complete the assessments and have the reports is February 2025.

• City's Conservation Assessments and CIP Update

Christine: Waiting for some further information from some staff, then will gather two quotes. Likely to be complete in April 2025.

• Discussion of MOU signing and public information
